



**DIRECTIONS:**

Clappers Farm  
Clappers Farm Road  
Silchester Reading RG7 2LE

**FROM Junction 11 on the M4:**

Take the A33 South towards Basingstoke and follow to Sherfield on Loddon (about 5 miles).  
At roundabout (with Mill pub/restaurant as LH exit) TURN RIGHT (for Bramley)  
After 50 yards, meet staggered X roads with PO on LHS, go STRAIGHT ON  
Follow road into Bramley, go over Level X-ing, and after 500 yards TURN RIGHT into Minchens Lane  
Follow Minchens Lane to end, T junction, TURN LEFT  
Follow road approx. 0.5 mile and TURN (1<sup>st</sup>) RIGHT into Clappers Farm Road  
Follow road (which narrows considerably) to sharp left hand bend  
Immediately after bend, Clappers Farm on RHS. Follow road round front of farm, through the ford and entrance to event is 1<sup>st</sup> gate on RHS after ford.

**FROM Junction 6 on the M3:**

Take main Basingstoke ring road and follows signs and get onto A33 for Reading  
Follow A33 to Sherfield on Loddon and continue until you hit roundabout (with Mill pub/restaurant on RH exit). TURN LEFT for Bramley  
After 50 yards, meet staggered X roads with PO on LHS, go STRAIGHT ON  
Follow road into Bramley, go over Level X-ing, and after 500 yards TURN RIGHT into Minchens Lane  
Follow Minchens Lane to end, T junction, TURN LEFT  
Follow road approx. 0.5 mile and TURN (1<sup>st</sup>) RIGHT into Clappers Farm Road  
Follow road (which narrows considerably) to sharp left hand bend  
Immediately after bend, Clappers Farm on RHS. Follow road round front of farm, through the ford and entrance to event is 1<sup>st</sup> gate on RHS after ford.

**FROM TADLEY:**

If you can get onto the main drag through Tadley where Traffic Lights are just by Lloyds Bank  
Turn to follow signposts to Silchester/Pamber Heath (right if coming from Basingstoke, left if coming from Aldermaston)  
Follow road to T junction with Calleva Arms pub on RHS. TURN RIGHT  
TURN immediately LEFT into Holly Lane  
Follow road for 2 miles until you see Clappers Farm Road on left. TURN LEFT  
Follow road (which narrows considerably) to sharp left hand bend.  
Immediately after bend, Clappers Farm on RHS. Follow road round front of farm, through the ford and entrance to the event is 1<sup>st</sup> gate on RHS after ford.

1. To be judged under British Dressage (BD) rules
2. Judges decision is final
3. All horses and ponies to be 4 years old and over
4. The landowners, organisers and officials shall not be held responsible for anything that may happen to competitors, spectators, their property servants or animals in connection with or arising out of this event. It is a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the organisers against any claim for loss, damage or legal action.
5. Entry fees will only be refunded on production of a vet or doctor's certificate within 2 days of the date of the show.
6. Tadley & District Riding Club reserves the right to vary or cancel the event. In the event of cancellation there will be a £1 administration fee.
7. Correct riding attire must be worn by all competitors in line with RC rules. In particular, everyone mounted, whether a competitor or not, must wear a hat complying with **PAS015/BSI Kitemarked or VG1 01.040/BSI Kitemarked** with the harness properly adjusted and fastened (full details Appendix CR4: Dress Guidelines of BRC handbook at [www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-handbook](http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-handbook). Failure to do so will incur elimination. Body protectors are also highly recommended.
8. The promoters reserve the right to refuse any entry without giving any reason whatsoever.
9. It is the responsibility of competitors to know the rules – our stewards and officials are there to help and advise. Please remember all our helpers are volunteers.
